Judges Critique

MPD (10 Entries) Abs: 1

1st: CHRISTIE'S Sophtspot Abracadabra, moderate attractively decorated b/w, pleasing head and alert expression, well proportioned forehand, good legs and feet, level topline, strong loin, well angulated hindquarters with well let-down hocks, sound drive and tracking made him easily the best mover in this class, well presented and capably handled. 2nd: BEAUMONT & CROFT'S Koroyza Candy Man, well pigmented b/w, pleasing masculine head, tapered neck, good lay of shoulder and overall forehand angulation, a depth of brisket and good topline and tailset, sound well developed hindquarters, good striding movement. 3rd: WILLIAMS' Phadante Brighton Rock

1st: CHRISTIE'S Sophtspot Abracadabra 2nd: HERNANDEZ'S Dalminshi Star Gazer, moderate youngster with pleasing masculine head, well pigmented b/w decoration, good lay of shoulder, level topline with strength in the loin, sound hindquarters with developed second thigh, well let down hocks, moved soundly, well handled. 3rd: SWINDELLS' Pjasdals Cwite Starstruck

PGD (11 Entries) Abs: 21st: ELY'S Wintermine Dynamo, strong masculine l/w, balanced overall construction, well proportioned head, tapered neck into defined wither and good forehand, well sprung rib, a depth of brisket and strong loin, powerful well angulated and muscled hindquarters, one of just a handful of males who both drove with power and tracked with precision. 2nd: GOFF-LEGGETT'S Washakie Aslan, moderate and balanced l/w, most attractive head with pleasing expression, an elegant neck into good wither, topline and tailset. Mature well developed body with strong quarters, round bone and cat feet, good ring presence, powerful striding movement. 3rd: WHITING'S Dalesbred Jamaica At Cragvaille

OD (11 Entries) Abs: 2: 1st: CUTTS' Ch Kaytian Kalypso To Marzelina, top quality dog, strong and masculine with balanced symmetry overall, good l/w decoration, most attractive head with alert expression and nicely decorated ears, arched tapered neck into well defined wither, sound well laid and proportioned forehand, a defined sternum, good spring of rib and a depth of brisket, round bone, sprung pasterns and tight feet, strong loin, powerful well developed and angulated hindquarters, moved with lateral drive and tracked precisely, good demeanour. 2nd: MOORE'S Ch Fincham Trade Wind JW, a close decision, another top quality male of substance with balanced overall proportions, very eye-catching nicely distributed b/w decoration, masculine head with dark eye, good earset and carriage, long elegant neck, excellent forehand angulation and proportions, sound body with plenty of heart and lung room, powerful loin, a turn of stifle and width of thigh, well defined hocks, soundness and strength giving powerful striding movement, showed very well. VD (1 Entries) Abs: 01st: MCCARTHY'S Ch & Ir Ch Tollwood Lionel At Kilndandy JW, top quality male in excellent condition, still a strong worthy competitor for top honours, just lost out on the day to two males in their prime with his son taking the CC, beautiful head and elegant neck, sound forehand, good feet and bone, a spring of rib, depth of brisket and strong loin, powerful and properly angulated hindquarters used most effectively to deliver sound driving movement, competently presented.

PGB (16 Entries) Abs: 61st: SCOTT-ALLEN & DAVIS' Tolutim Zaffre, well-made b/w, moderate and balanced overall with a clean outline, pleasing head framed by well set ears, elegant neck into wither and level topline, good forehand with a lay of shoulder, depth of body, spring of rib and strong loin, well muscled hindquarters with a bend of stifle and defined hocks, moved freely with powerful striding action. 2nd: PILGRIM'S Olbero One To Charm At Weaponness, very feminine, elegant and well covered l/w with typical head and appealing expression, well laid shoulder and sound overall forequarter, good spring of rib and strong in loin, good topline and tailset, sound hindquarters used effectively to give free driving movement. 3rd: RICHARDSON'S Pearly Naughty Las At Jomihvar

Feminine head on a most elegant neck into a clean defined wither, excellent forehand, round bone, a spring of pastern and cat feet, level topline into croup and tailset, a depth of brisket, spring of rib and strong loin, well muscled and angulated hindquarters, plenty behind the tail, even and clear b/w decoration, moved with drive, tracked with precision, showed with animation, handled with empathy. Excelled on the day, pleased to award her the CC (her third) and BOB, delighted with her Group 4. 2nd: HARRISON-STRATFORD'S Dalkereve Dark N Divine JW, similar positive attributes to 1, the overall picture is one of femininity, elegance, symmetry and balance, beautifully presented, evenly distributed b/w spotting, a typical head and alert expression, long tapered neck and a clean wither, good forequarters with a lay of shoulder, well sprung rib, depth of brisket and powerful loin, good topline and tailset, sound hindquarters with a turn of stifle and second thigh, moved with effortless driving action, showed well, at one with the handler. 3rd: RANCE'S Olbero One To Treasure
