Judge's Critique

Firstly, I should like to thank all exhibitors for giving me such a quality entry. All were well presented and in good condition. I was impressed with the overall standard especially in the bitches. In some classes really good Dalmatians had to go cardless. Fronts have much improved since I last judged the breed. This depth of quality that I found from minor puppy to open bodes well for the breed. Temperaments were good, a couple of shy youngsters but hopefully time and patience will remedy this. In the upper classes I was splitting hairs in my placings and I am sure many of these will swap around during the show season.

1st Stokes Elaridge Quincie, 7 month old liver dog of excellent colour, lovely head, well arched neck, into good shoulders good depth of brisket, strong hindquarters, good feet, moved very well for such a baby, even decoration. A lovely boy who I am sure has a bright future. BP
2nd Carvell's Timmy Willie with Lilal another very promising young male, very well presented black spotted with sparkling white coat, pleasing head, good reach of neck, good bone, nice bend of stifle, pressed winner hard, but today I preferred the overall balance and movement of Quincie. 1st Saunders Dallydyl Imaginary Friend, liver of super type, really liked this exuberant lad, lovely head, good reach of neck, good shoulder placement, but at the moment carrying a little too much weight on his shoulders, hopefully this is temporary, a really good Dalmatian who also covered the ground with ease, seriously considered him for Res CC
2nd Peterson's buffrey Beau Belle at Daedalus, Upstanding strong well made black, lovely expression, strong neck well made front good top line, well let down hocks, not so evenly decorated as winner

1st Wright's Ffiglina New Horizons at Milbelle, real quality dog, rich liver colour, good decoration, shown in excellent condition, handsome head, well arched neck, good lay of shoulder, straight strong bone, correct top line, good bend of stifle moved really well, beautifully handled and presented Res CC
2nd Oatridge Dalehouse Rockafella, heavier spotted black dog, but sound honest Dalmatian, very kind expression, well bodied up, strong hindquarters, excellent showman, powerful mover.

Lovely class! 1st Goff-Leggett's Ch Washakie Chief as Great As, well known Champion who does not disappoint when going over him, super type, a real showman expertly handled, pleasing expression, good front, plenty of heart and lung room, strong well arched neck, deep brisket, uses his strong hindquarters to really cover the ground, an excellent representative of the breed CC and BOB
2nd McCarthy's Ch Tollwood Lionel at Kilndandy, judged him as a puppy, and I am pleased to see he has matured into a lovely dog, very well made all through, a strong dog, good fore and aft, correct topline, excellent spotting and good liver colour, preferred today the showmanship of winner.

1st Saffhills Sweet singing Nightingale, 9 month old black spotted bitch of overall good type, pleasing expression, good depth of chest, would prefer more width through stifle, moved soundly

JB 21 (5abs)

A fantastic class and I am sorry that some really good bitches went cardless, the first five in this class will I am sure change places many times

1st Forrest's Choosespots Camelia by Spotswood, lovely liver bitch full of quality, super head with appealing expression, correct eye colour, good front, good lay of shoulder, nicely decorated, well arched neck, strong hindquarters which she used to advantage around the ring

2nd Neath Duggan's Buffrey Maybee, a real classy bitch, deepest of black pigment, so much to like about her, good head, dark eye, good reach of neck, good angulation front and rear, moved very well but felt in the final run round winner just had a little more reach and drive, expertly handled by this exhibitor.

3rd Gatford's Phaeland Phiddling Phorever

Another quality class

1st Lamb's Leaveslake Lily at Dalpetro, good decoration of excellent liver colour on this bitch, attractive head and expression, well boned, good front and deep brisket, correct top line strong hindquarters with correct bend of stifle, a very showy and good moving bitch

2nd Scott Allen and Davis Olbero Olympic Rose, black spotted quality bitch, very well made, good straight bone into correct cat feet, keeps her topline on the move, good angulation front and rear, underline needs to tighten up a little more, but nevertheless a very lovely girl
